But Jim's new life starts to unravel when the rest of his old New York song and dance trio – Ted Hanover (**Kyle Golemba**) and Lila Dixon (**Kimberley Rampersad**) – come to town. The Festival Theatre is home to this cherished holiday classic featuring a cornucopia of timeless Irving Berlin songs including *Heat Wave*, *Chasing the Blues Away*, *Blue Skies*, *Cheek to Cheek*, *Easter Parade* and *White Christmas*.
